

About a mile from Gays Staithe is Alderfen Broad, which is one of Norfolk's hidden treasures. This land-locked broad is now a nature reserve. Keep a look out for barn owls quartering the fields as you walk along the footpaths; they are not nocturnal, but hunt during the day.



There are marked signs showing a circular walk. You will need waterproof footwear if it has rained recently!

A path leads to a viewing platform overlooking the broad. From here you may be lucky enough to see kingfishers, otters or even visiting osprey at the right time of year.
