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## MINUTES OF A PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

### 1. TO APPOINT A CHAIR FOR THE MEETING

R Hanger was proposed by N Fowle and seconded by P Ryall to act as chair due to the chair and vice chair being absent. All agreed and R Hanger continued to chair the rest of the meeting

4.1 Cllr Richard Price spoke about budget cuts at Norfolk County Council. He also spoke of meeting with the Head of Child Services and looking at how to provide the best education to children.

4.2 A parishioner spoke about their efforts to get better broadband speeds in the village. It has been noted that some works are due to commence, but further work needs to be done to get better service for all in the village.

The same parishioner also wanted to give thanks for the generous collection for the British Legion which raised £2339.

A parishioner spoke about Lime Kiln Dyke. The Broads Authority are helping with signs to improve the situation with noise pollution and keeping the area clean and tidy.
