1. APOLOGIES

7. PARISH STAITHE.

7.1 Registration of ownership/Lease. The Chair and Clerk are meeting with the Solicitor next Thursday. To ask about electricity connection.

7.2 Engine running – This is an ongoing issue, and not acceptable. It is an offence under the Navigation Byelaws 1995 Emission of Smoke or Fumes or the Making of Noise 84, 'The master of a vessel shall not permit the vessel to emit smoke or fumes or make any noise or nuisance which gives reasonable grounds for annoyance to another person'. If any problems occur under this, or any other byelaw, River Control can be contacted on 01692 678459 at the time.

7.3 The fencing and trees were discussed on 7th December 1998, and recommended actions and quotations reported to the meeting on 24th February 1999. The completion of the works was detailed on 3rd June 1999 recording that Mrs England had elected to keep her own fence demarking the boundary, and the fence on that side was within the Staithe boundary.
