

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO6822) affecting the Hall Road from its junction with Long Road for 50m westwards in the PARISH OF BARTON TURF & IRSTEAD to facilitate UK Power Networks electrical works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 day within the period.

Alternative route is via: Hall Road, Irstead Road, The Street, School Lane, School Road, King Street, Water Lane, Long Road (Neatishead, Barton Turf).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

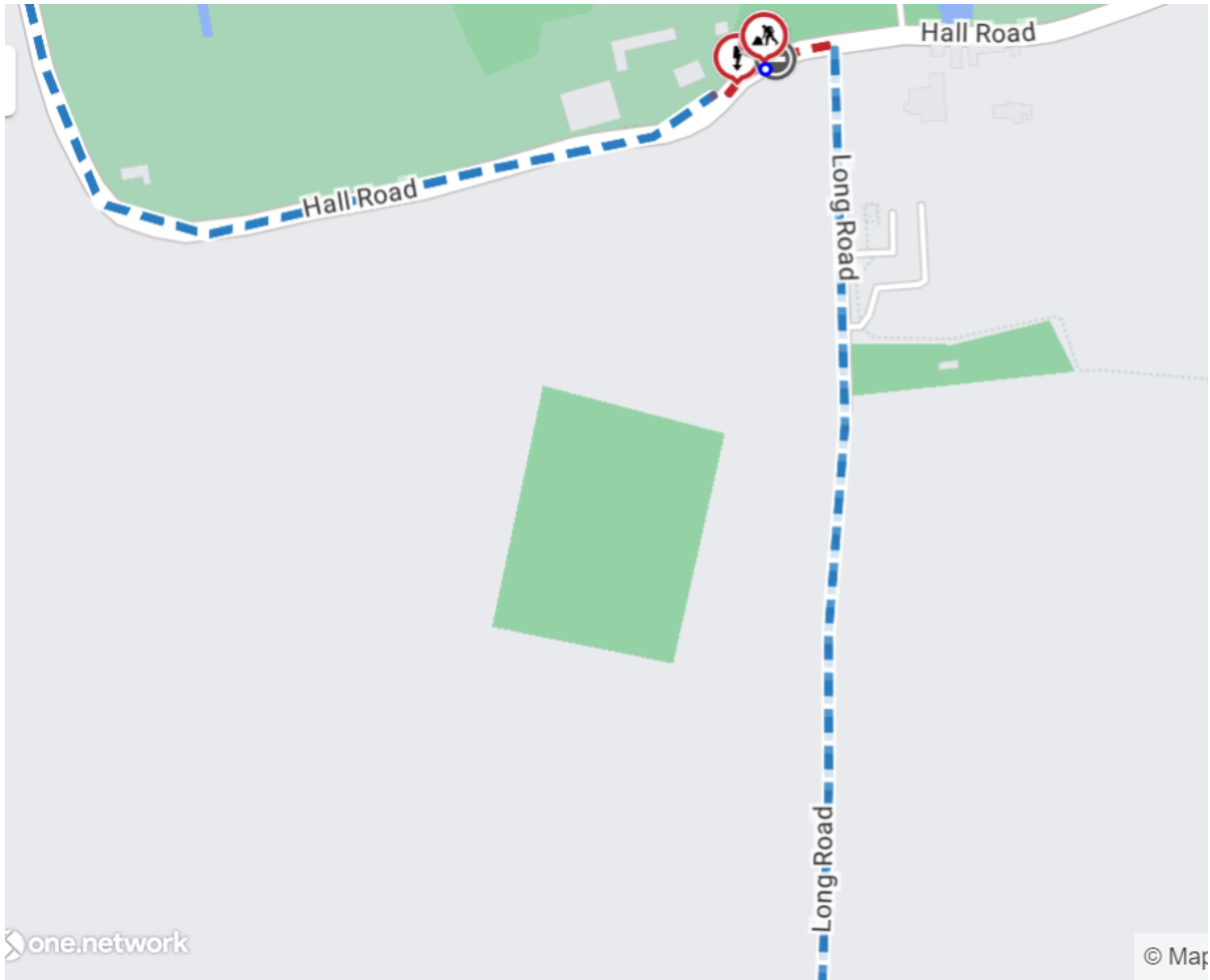
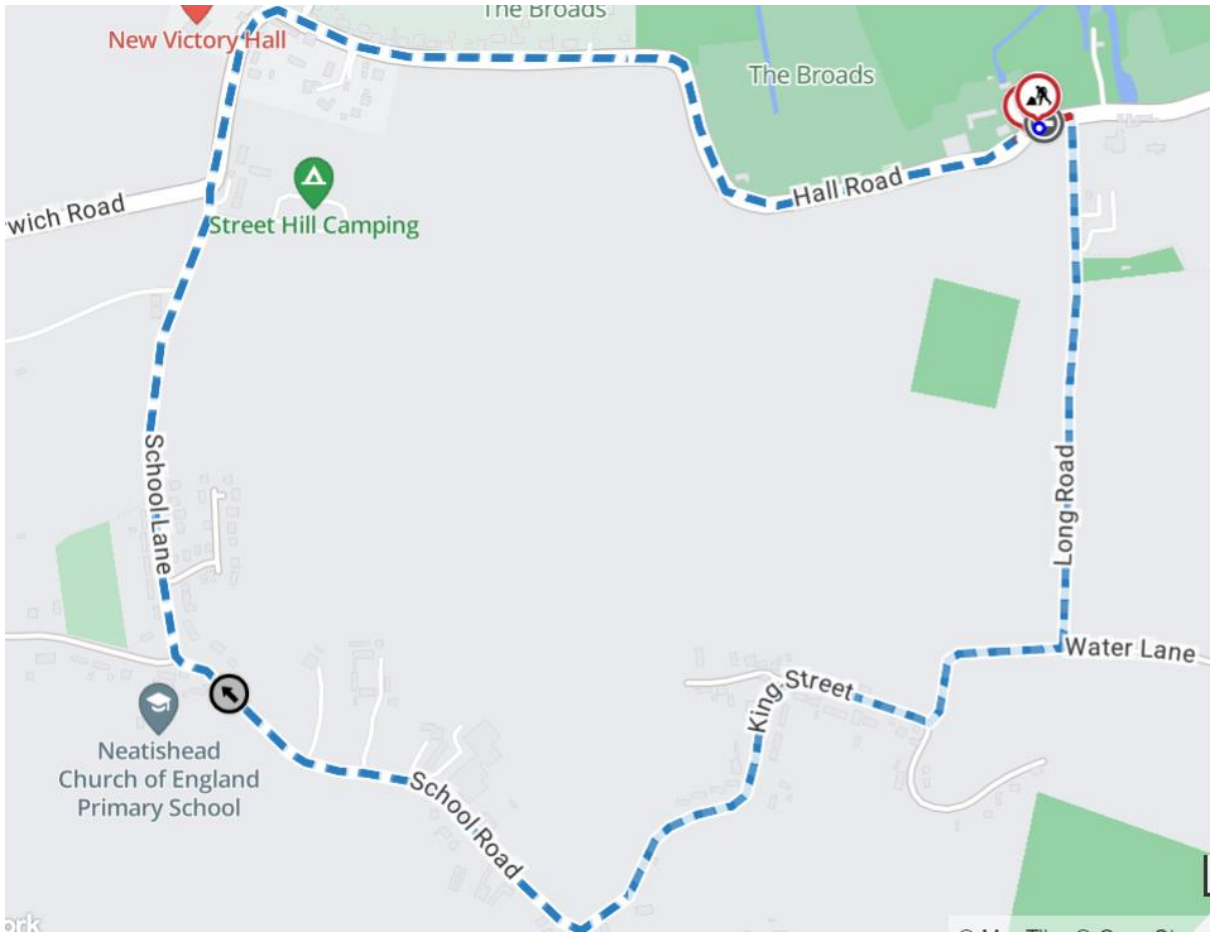
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
