I am writing to invite you to a public meeting regarding the recent flooding in North Norfolk.

I know it has been a difficult few weeks with some severe flooding in many areas across North Norfolk. I have seen for myself that Potter Heigham, Horning, Hickling, Sheringham and the Glaven Valley have all suffered flooding due to the unprecedented amount of rain we have been experiencing. Having personally visited flood-affected areas and engaged with local volunteer flood wardens, I have gained first-hand insight into the challenges faced by these communities. I wish to assure you that finding a solution for this is of the utmost importance to me.

I have therefore organised a public meeting for Friday  $2^{nd}$  February to discuss what can be done in relation to this. The meeting will take place at Hickling Barn Community Centre, from 19:00 – 21:00.
