

Police Neighbourhood Beat Manager Report

Good evening,

Unfortunately, I am unable to attend the meeting, so please accept this written report for the period 08/04/2025 to 08/04/2026.

During this period, there were 48 calls made from the parish. These are broken down as follows:

- 4 emergency calls, all relating to road traffic collisions (two of which were connected to the same incident)
- 6 priority calls, none of which resulted in any significant concern, with four relating to the same location
- 2 scheduled calls, with no issues of concern
- 33 calls requiring no police attendance, including requests for information, matters resolved with advice, or issues not requiring police involvement
- 3 appointments for low-level personal matters dealt with appropriately

Overall, there are no significant issues to report within the parish during this period. However, residents are encouraged to continue reporting any concerns as they arise.

On a personal note, due to ongoing health and work-related circumstances, I have had to take a significant amount of time away from operational duties and have recently been office-based. As a result, I have taken the decision to retire in June. My post has now been advertised, and a replacement Beat Manager will be appointed in due course.

In the meantime, colleagues from the Safer Neighbourhood Team at North Walsham will continue to provide cover and support for the parish.

Finally, I would like to thank the parish for their support over the past four years. It has been a privilege to serve the community, and I am sorry I have not been as visible recently. I have particularly missed attending local events such as school visits and community parades.
