

CHURCH

St Peter's Church continues to play an active role in village life, supported by a dedicated group of volunteers.

Over the past year there have been some changes within the church team, particularly around the flower and festival rotas, with new volunteers stepping in to take on these roles, and we are very grateful for their support.

The churchyard continues to be maintained by a small volunteer team, and thanks are also due to those who ensure the church remains clean and welcoming for both the community and visitors.

Regular worship continues, with monthly Sunday services, weekly Morning Prayer, and other pastoral services throughout the month. The church also continues to support the wider community through weddings, funerals, and well-attended seasonal services such as Midnight Mass.

Links with Neatishead School remain strong, with regular visits, assemblies, and Harvest Festival support, and the Sunday Club continues to meet twice a month for younger children.

In terms of the building, recent works have included the successful completion of the bellcote restoration and ongoing maintenance and grant-funded work on the church fabric.

Looking ahead, a community celebration is planned for September 2026, with the Bishop of Norwich expected to attend.

Finally, the church continues to rely heavily on volunteers, and more support is needed across all areas to ensure it can continue to serve the community in the future.
